

eCert Upload Template

This template is designed to assist you in uploading images to eCert Chamber. This first example is used to create the **signature** of the Chamber Authorized Officer(s). Page 2 gives you the sizes for other images...

Prerequisites

You will need a scanner that saves to PDF and Adobe Acrobat Reader installed.

Step 1

Print this page

Step 2

Using a <u>THICK</u> pen (preferably blue), sign your name into the box below, as largely as possible <u>without</u> touching the black edge

Step 3

Place this page on your Scanner, and scan it in colour, saving it to PDF

Step 4

Open the PDF file you have created (using Adobe Acrobat Reader), and select the "SNAPSHOT TOOL" from the menu. (This can be found under the Tools\Basic menu in Acrobat Reader Version 7, or under "Tools\Select and Zoom" in Adobe Acrobat Version 8).

Step 5

Using the Snapshot Tool, click and drag from the top left point of the box to the bottom right corner of the box, without selecting any part of the black edge.

Step 6

Open Microsoft Paint by selecting start / All Programs / Accessories / Paint and make the blank canvas very small (you can choose Image/Attributes and make the width and height 0.1 each)

Step 7

Select Edit / Paste from the Paint menu – your signature will appear.

Step 8

| Select File / Save As and choose "Save as type" = JPEG, and save the file to a place where you can access | | | | |
